

Telco firm owner admits not submitting GST accounts

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IPOH: An owner of a telecommunications company has been slapped with eight charges for failure to submit Goods and Services Tax statements.

Wong Kean Yik, 35, who owns Sun Yi Telecommunication Trading, pleaded guilty to all charges after they were read to him before Sessions Court judge Murtazadi Amran.

In the charges, read separately, he was charged with failure to submit GST statements from May until December last year under Section 41(1) of the Goods and Services Tax Act 2014.

All of the offences were under Section 41 (6) of the same Act and punishable by a fine not exceeding RM50,000 for each charge, or jail of up to three years' or both for each count.

Wong had asked the court to defer the case's decision to enable him to pay the fine.

Murtazadi allowed Wong's application and deferred the decision to Oct 19.

Perak Royal Malaysian Customs officer S. Morgan prosecuted, while the accused was unrepresented.
