RON95, RON97 down 5 sen

KUALA LUMPUR: The prices of petrol will decrease by five sen per litre effective today.

Petroleum Dealers Association of Malaysia deputy president Datuk Zulkifli Mokti confirmed that RON95 will be priced at RM1.70 per litre and RON97 at RM2.05 per litre.

The price of diesel remains unchanged at RM1.70 per litre.

The government had removed fuel subsidies in December 2014, and sets the prices of petrol and diesel on a managed float every month.
