## Dream home turns to nightmare

JOHOR BARU: First-time housebuyer Nora dreamt for months of moving into her own house after securing a loan through a lawyer for an affordable home in Johor. Then, it was time to get the keys to her dream home. And her excite-

ment turned to despair.

Nora, a civil servant, was told by the developer that the cheque issued by her lawyer totalling more than RM140,000 had bounced.

"I was so upset and went to the lawyer's office but they kept giving me excuses. I decided to lodge a police report," she said.

"I heard about this Johor affordable house scheme last year and decided to apply for it. I was happy when I was selected and the developer assigned this lawyer to do the necessary documents.

"But I suspected something amiss when my government loan was approved but the developer did not give me the keys to the house once it was completed," said Nora, who now has RM700 deducted from her salary for the Johor affordable September.
