"Many thanks to my Cabinet colleagues, employees of the Ministry of Finance (MoF), relevant agencies and the people for all their support.


"InsyaAllah, I will always give 100 per cent focus on the welfare of the people and the sustainability of the country's economy," he shared his journey at the MoF on his social media account.
