**RON97 AND DIESEL RETAIL PRICES
RAISED BY 6 SEN PER LITRE FROM 30 OCTOBER 2025 TO 5 NOVEMBER 2025**

Following the recent climb in global oil prices, the Government has set the retail price of RON97 at **RM3.20 per litre**, while diesel in Peninsular Malaysia is set at **RM2.95 per litre from 30 October 2025 to 5 November 2025**.

The Government will continue to review and adjust RON97 and diesel retail prices in line with movements in the current global oil markets. Even so, price stability remains the foremost priority.

Using the Automatic Pricing Mechanism (APM) formula, retail prices for petroleum products from **30 October 2025 to 5 November 2025** are:

- (i) RON97 petrol rises by 6 sen to RM3.20 per litre;
- (ii) Non-subsidised RON95 petrol remains at RM2.60 per litre;
- (iii) Subsidised RON95 petrol under BUDI95 remains at RM1.99 per litre;
- (iv) Diesel in Peninsular Malaysia rises by 6 sen to RM2.95 per litre; and
- (v) Diesel in Sabah, Sarawak and Labuan remains at RM2.15 per litre.

The Government will continue monitoring global oil price trends and take appropriate measures to ensure people's welfare remains intact.
